

Zhi-Xing China Fellowships is an umbrella fellowship programs that are designed to facilitate exchanges of people and ideas and to promote friendship. From mid-career professionals to university and high school students, the Fellowships program offers a myriad of activities that are tailored to the needs of different groups during their visits in China.



Zhi-Xing China Fellowships

For Industry Elites

Duration: 3-4 weeks from April to June

The Applicants should:

- * Be between the ages of 32 to 45
- Have a minimum of 5 to 10 years of progressive responsible experience in leadership positions:
- ** Demonstrate strong sense of social responsibility and intercultural communication capacities
- * Be willing to promote industrial development
- * Be interested in exploring partnership with China

Format & Gains:

Within the 4-week customized visits that are tailored their interests, the fellows will visit 4-6 cities in China. The Fellowships offers opportunities to engage in in-depth conversations with experts and professionals within their respective fields as well as Chinese citizens, seeing China through both historical and contemporary lenses.

For Presidents, Administrative Staffs, and Professors from Universities

Zhi-Xing China: China-U.S. Academic Impact Program

Duration: 2 weeks in June each year

The Applicants should:

- * Be Presidents, administrative staffs, professors of universities, state universities or community colleges
- * Under the age of 60
- * Be willing to establish contact and collaboration with Chinese universities and scholars

Format & Gains:

The program invites participants to visit higher education institutions and educational departments in 2-3 cities in China, in which they would have the opportunity to have dialogues with senior administrators of the universities as well as experts in education and relevant fields. It seeks to introduce the Chinese history, language and cultures and enhance communication between relevant parties from both sides.

For College Students

Zhi-Xing China: China-U.S. University Student Leaders Academy Duration: 2-3 weeks each summer

The Applicants should:

- * Be enrolled in the first year to fourth year of studies or equivalent institution towards the completion of a degree (minimum Bachelor's level or equivalent)
- * Have a strong sense of social responsibility
- * Have internship or work experiences in international organization or private sectors
- * Have demonstrated leadership capability or has served in a senior leadership position of a student-led organization,
- * Are willing to facilitate bilateral relationships between U.S. and China and aims to act upon their shares of responsibilities to the world.

Format & Gains:

Undergraduate students from American and Chinese universities are invited to carry out social research activities in China. During the course of the program, students are offered with a myriad of research activities including seminars, lectures and site visits in 3-4 cities in China, in which they can learn more about Chinese politics, economy, culture and more. The research topics include Create in China and the Era of Big Data, Sustainable Development and Public Policy, and Social Reforms and Development, etc. It will conclude with a certificate of completion after presenting final capstone projects.

For Administrators, Superintendents and Principals at Elementary and Middle Schools

Zhi-Xing China: State and Provincial Education Administrators Program

Duration: 10 days from June to November each year

The program is open to:

U.S. state government education administrators, superintendents or principals who seek to establish cooperative relationships with local education departments as well as K-12 schools in China.

Format & Gains:

The U.S. representatives are invited to China, visiting different sectors of Chinese education departments, universities, and K-12 schools. Through the visits, they would not only be able to explore more on the reforms of China's basic education in key areas, including digitalization, curriculum and teaching materials, teacher development, and testing and assessment, but also have the chance to have in-depth discussion with the Chinese counterparts.

For High School Students

Zhi-Xing China: China-U.S. Outstanding High School Students Exchange Program

Duration: 2 weeks every summer

The Applicants should:

- * Be enrolled in a high school
- * Have a proven academic track record
- * Have a demonstrated ability to successfully interact with individuals of different cultural backgrounds
- * Have the willingness to understand and learn more about China and its culture

Format & Gains:

Through cultural lectures, visits, and seminars, participants can learn about Chinese history, culture, and educational development. American students are invited to the house of Chinese families where they are able to experience the everyday life of as a Chinese. The program seeks to promote mutual understanding and friendship between U.S. and China.
